This kit allows the boilers wall mounted horizontal flue to be extended vertically on the outside wall, this enables the flue products to be emitted at a higher level where pluming is not detrimental.





5 PLUME KIT FLUE OUTLET TERMINAL POSITIONING

IMPORTANT: For stated clearances for the flue outlet terminal in relation to openings, air inlet etc., refer to the Flue Installation section of the boiler Installation Instructions.

Due to the high efficiency of these boilers pluming will occur. For this reason terminal positions which could cause problems should where possible be avoided.

Particular care should be taken in the case of large multiple boiler installations and complying with the requirements of the clean air act.

The minimum siting dimensions for the terminal positions, A, B, C stated can be applied when a high level flue outlet kit is fitted. The information below is extracted from BS. 5440 Pt. 1 and is for boilers with heat inputs not exceeding 70 kW nett, and the latest Building Regulations Part J. Detailed reference should still be made to these standards. In IE refer to I.S. 813:2002.


MINIMUM SITING DIMENSIONS FOR FANNED FLUE TERMINALS

Minimum Siting For Air Inlet

Α.	Directly below an opening, air brick, opening windows etc.	150mm
В.	Directly above an opening, air brick, opening windows etc.	300mm
C.	Horizontally to an opening air brick, opening windows etc.	150mm

Minimum Siting For Flue Outlet

- A. Directly below an opening, air brick, opening windows (Horizontal Discharge). 300 mm
- B. Directly above an opening, air brick, opening windows (Horizontal Discharge). 300 mm
- C. Horizontally to an opening air brick, opening windows etc. 300 mm



Note: The flue outlet termination should not be installed less than two metres above ground level.

HEAT INPUTS IN EXCESS OF 70KW NETT

For boiler installations with total heat inputs in excess of 70kW nett, reference should be made to BS6644 and IGEM/UP/10. IN IE refer to I.S.820.2000

6 FLUING OPTIONS

The maximum permissible length of the external flue tube is ten metres. (See dimension Y below). This will reduce in proportion to the internal flue duct length (dimension X) and internal and external elbows fitted.

Size the internal and external ductwork lengths in accordance Table 1 and Table 2 for 80/125mm and 100/150mm systems respectively. If using optional 45 and 90 degree elbows the maximum permissible flue length 'X' must be reduced by the equivalent values depicted in Table 3.

For each additional elbow used the length 'X' must be reduced by the following values.



EXTENSION OF INTERNAL CONCENTRIC SECTION – FITMENT OF ADDITIONAL CONCENTRIC ELBOWS

The internal concentric flue section can be extended within the constraints of parameter 'X' shown in Table 1 & 2 for 80/125 & 100/150 mm systems respectively.

When doing this, if internal concentric elbows are fitted, the equivalent resistance must be subtracted from the permissible length 'X' depicted in Fig 1. The equivalent resistance for internal concentric elbows is provided in the main Evomax 2 Installation & Servicing booklet.



7 KIT FITTING


FIG 3 - SYSTEM INSTALLATION

Fig 3 depicts a typical installation schematic.


Important Notes

(1.0) Ensure all horizontal flue runs incorporate a fall of no less then 1.5° back to the boiler to ensure flue condensate drains back through the boiler appliance.

(2.0) The flue and air terminals must be separated by a distance of at least 500mm.

(3.0) When assembling the flue components the seals should be lubricated with water. **Do not use other lubricants.**





Fitting Procedure

- a. Refer to the boiler installation manual to fit the horizontal concentric flue section. Take care to ensure a minimum fall back to the appliance of 1.5° to ensure flue condensate drains back through the boiler appliance. Use only water to lubricate flue pipe seals to aid assembly.
- b. Fit the wall termination elbow / internal and external wall sealing plates and rain cowl (UIN 220922 or 220923).
 When fitting the rain cowl assembly ensure all of the components, including the air grill, is pushed fully home into their mating parts.
- c. Fit the required extension pipes UIN 213274 or 213277 90° elbows UIN 213272 or 213275 45° elbows UIN 213273 or 213276

- d. Secure the external flue pipe to the wall using the brackets provided. For horizontal elements ensure a minimum fall back to the appliance of 1.5° to ensure flue condensate drains back through the boiler appliance.
- e. Fit the 90° flue exit elbow and the horizontal flue exit pipe (UIN 220922 or 220923).
- f. When installing the system, ensure the distance between the air inlet terminal (rain cowl air inlet) and flue exit pipe is a minimum of 500mm. This requirement <u>must</u> be complied with.
- g. Ensure all flue components are fully pushed home and are adequately supported.



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
